

HD Degreaser

DESCRIPTION

HD Degreaser is a concentrated, heavy duty cleaner which should be diluted before use.

On contact with concrete surfaces, *HD Degreaser* will act quickly to soften, lift, and remove a wide range of oils, polymers, fats and greases associated with foot and vehicular traffic.

HD Degreaser is suitable for cleaning both domestic and commercial concrete floors prior to the application of CCS Decorative Concrete Products and ACS Floor Coating Systems.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

HD Degreaser should never be used in its concentrated form. Recommended dilution rates are as follows:-

Oil and grease stains	2 parts water
Degreaser, for domestic driveways, commercial car parks and workshops	5 parts water
General purpose cleaning	10 parts water
New colored concrete	20 parts water

HD Degreaser should be applied using a low pressure nap sack type sprayer or an industrial mop.

Where necessary the degreaser should be scrubbed into the surface.

Rinse clean using a high pressure water blaster or an auto scrubbing machine and allow to dry.

PACKAGING

HD Degreaser is available in a 20 litre plastic drum.

STORAGE

Store away from other chemicals such as Class 5 oxidizers (such as granular chlorine etc.).

FIRE

The product is non-flammable and poses no fire risk.
